On 1 February a Zoom meeting of the committee was held, there were 18 members online.



Several members have commented that they found it, and particularly the subsequent talk given by Marian Miller, useful and informative. I was personally relieved that the technology didn't give us too many problems.

Because of Covid restrictions, none of our regular FoNC activities are taking place at present, but we can still enjoy the attractions of our Common, whether walking, cycling or riding. Last month, I started to write about the problems posed by nonnative, invasive animal species which have become established and are causing problems, in and around Naphill – covering three mammals: the Grey Squirrel, Glis glis and Muntjac. So this month we'll look at three non-mammals.



To begin with, the Ring-necked Parakeet. They were first seen in significant numbers around the Thames in London, during the 1970s. Today their flocks have grown to huge numbers around Twickenham and Kew, and they have spread along the Thames and are now a common sight in Marlow and, more recently, Oxford. They remain rare in Wycombe, but they've visited our bird feeders on a couple of occasions, most recently last year. There's an urban myth that they were initially released after the 1950 filming of John Huston's The African Queen, where they were used to create a tropical feel on set at Shepperton, but there's no evidence for this. These spectacular birds are about magpie sized, with a similarly long tail, but bright green in colour with a vivid red bill quite unmistakable!

The next species I'd like to consider is the Asian Hornet, inadvertently brought to France from east Asia in 2004. It is a voracious predator on bees, including honeybees, and has caused significant problems for French beekeepers. Nests have been identified in Somerset and Gloucestershire, so it's not impossible they may be in the Chilterns, although there was only one confirmed sighting last year (in Gosport). Our native European Hornet resembles a large wasp, but the Asian variety has an abdomen that is almost entirely black with a single yellow band. Because they are a notifiable species, all sightings must be reported immediately – there's even an Asian Hornet Watch app!

Just to put your minds at rest – because I know some people have been worried – this is not the Asian (or Japanese) Giant Hornet that you may have seen on TV nature programmes and grows to 2" or 5cm long. The Asian Hornet is slightly smaller than our native species, so only half this size. It's worth pointing out that, while many people are understandably nervous around them, hornets are (unlike wasps) not aggressive and, being carnivorous, have no interest in our picnics. If you find a nest on your property, best advice is to leave it alone – hornets will do a great job of keeping garden pest insects under control.

Finally, the Signal Crayfish. Crayfish resemble a small (around 6" or 16cm) freshwater lobster, and were common in Chiltern chalk streams, with the native species being the white-clawed crayfish. In the 1970s, the British government introduced the signal crayfish from North America to UK waters to be 'farmed' for export. Unfortunately, it is a carrier of crayfish plague and is thought to be responsible for passing the deadly disease to our native crayfish, reducing their population to levels that are considered 'endangered'. Signal crayfish cause further problems by burrowing into river and canal banks causing erosion, bank collapse and sediment pollution. It is a fierce predator, feeding on a variety of fish, frogs and invertebrates, as well as plants, and even eating individuals of its own species. The Signal Crayfish is easily recognised by the bright red claws that give it its name.

Yet more on invasive plant species next month.

# Demystifying planning....a little - Permitted development and infilling explained

The sheer cost and disruption of selling and buying means that home owners are increasingly looking towards making improvements to their homes rather than moving. Building a small extension, adding a conservatory or converting a garage are commonplace alternatives. It is at the ideas stage that external advice should be sought if you are to avoid pitfalls and minimise the stress that building work brings! More often than not you will require planning permission even if you are simply updating your porch without increasing its size. At first glance this might seem onerous however there are sound reasons for this not least of which is the need to manage the visual impact of any home improvements. Living in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty nestling in the Green Belt we all have a responsibility to retain the character of our Green Belt Settlement and developments as a result are restricted. This is one reason why, for example the National Trust cannot simply chop down trees – permission is required so that the overall impact is assessed before chopping! This is more commonly known as Article 4. Visit www. planningportal.co.uk for further information.

# Permitted development

This is not to say that development is not allowed because that is not the case. However, what is permitted is defined. Permitted Development is broken down into 8 categories:

#### Class A:

covers the enlargement, improvement or alterations to a house such as rear or side extensions as well as general alterations such as new windows and doors. From 30 May 2013 to 30 May 2019 a neighbour consultation scheme for larger rear extensions under Class A is required.

#### Class B:

covers additions or alterations to roofs which enlarge the house such as loft conversions involving dormer windows.

#### Class C:

covers other alterations to roofs such as re-roofing or the installation of roof lights/windows.







#### Class D:

covers the erection of a porch outside an external door.

### Class E:

covers the provision of buildings and other development within the curtilage of the house.

#### Class F:

covers the provision of hard surfaces within the curtilage of the house such as driveways.

#### Class G:

covers the installation, alteration, or replacement of a chimney, flue or soil and vent pipe.

#### Class H:

covers the installation, alteration, or replacement of microwave antenna such as satellite dishes.

In addition there are rules relating to the erection or construction of gates, fences and walls, exterior painting, charging points for electric vehicles and CCTVs as well as the installation of solar panels.

A guide for householders can be found at :www.gov. uk/government/publications. Type in 'permitted development rights for householders' to access the technical guide. Your architect can also explain in layman's terms what this all means – it can seem confusing at times!

The Parish Council is a statutory consultee for planning applications and its committee meets every 3 weeks. Minutes of the Planning Committee are published on the Parish Council website (www.hughendenpc.org. uk/council-meetings/planning/ . This statutory role is an important one as the parish council is closest to the community and seeks to maintain the semi-rural nature of the area. Residents are also encouraged to post comments on the Buckinghamshire Council Planning Portal as these are considered carefully by both the Parish and the relevant Area Planning Committee. For Hughenden, the West Buckinghamshire Area Planning Committee considers each application on its merits, taking into account current legislation and planning policies. Committee papers can be found following

this link: <a href="https://bit.ly/3qeyTCt">https://bit.ly/3qeyTCt</a>. Personal opinions carry no weight even though at times an application stirs emotions – usually against granting planning permission. The planning pages of Buckinghamshire Council provides lots of useful information including where to record your comments on individual planning applications.

## Infilling

Whilst the Green Belt is heavily protected there are some exceptions when new buildings may be considered. For example, someone decides to build a house in the grounds of their house. This would be considered to be 'infilling' and the application will still be considered on its merits i.e. mindful that current planning rules are enforced.

## A final word on planning ....

Three words actually that are fast becoming the bane of a planning committee councillor: retrospective planning application. This is when the applicant has not sought planning permission at the outset. This can be risky and costly. Imagine having to pull down an extension. Ignorance is no excuse and architects will know exactly when planning permission is needed. When in doubt: contact the Planning Department for the Wycombe Area.

Please remember that planning rules are set at a national level and interpreted by local planning officers.

Wycombe District now has a Local Plan which has been absorbed by the new Unitary, Buckinghamshire Council. Here is the link to it: http://bit.ly/36TErdY. A growing number of parish councils are developing Neighbourhood Plans to influence the shape of future developments. Bledlow-cum-Saunderton Parish Council used their Neighbourhood Plan to successfully challenge a proposed major housing development on the old Molins site. Perhaps a Neighbourhood Plan is the way forward?

My daughter Charlotte's birthday this year happened to fall on Ash Wednesday, so we've had quite a number of conversations about Lent and the significance of this date for her birthday. I was fully expecting her to not 'do' Lent this year - she is a Sister in a major London hospital, at the forefront of caring for patients suffering from Covid and other ailments. For her, as for most of us, it seems like it has been Lent for the whole of the past year. We have all been forced to give up many of the pleasures we have taken for granted. Pleasures like leisurely swims in heated indoor pools, rumbustuous dinners out with friends, picnics, concerts, outings to the cinema, holidays to far away destinations that simultaneously relaxed and informed. For some of us, the only pleasure that remains is to curl up on the sofa dressed in a onesie, with a bar of chocolate in one hand and glass of wine in the other, watching boxed sets on Netflix. And now we are supposed to give up stuff like wine and chocolate!? For a whole six weeks!?

We belittle Lent when we see it as simply a season of 'giving up'. The purpose of the 'giving up' was to make space to better focus on spiritual reflection. Whatever your faith, taking time to reflect on the past year is vital and will help us to form some form of narrative on recent events. For two millennia, the Christian Church has provided a framework within such narratives can be structured, but it also

challenges us to view our lives through the lens of eternity. It will hold its most important celebration at the end of this month and the beginning of next -Easter. During the final week of March, we will retell the story of how a young, outspoken teacher in a small outpost of the Roman Empire was hounded to death as a matter of political expediency. A sad story that has many echoes for us now in the stories of those such as Thomas More, Edith Cavell and Archbishop Oscar Romero to name but a few. But where the Christian story differs is in what happened 3 days after Jesus was put to death. In a world-changing event that no one at the time saw coming, Jesus Christ overcame death and returned to life – an event known as the Resurrection which took place on the very first Easter Day.

For many of us, this will have been a difficult winter, adding on to a difficult year. Nothing will make any of this go away or change what has happened to our world. Lent gives us a 'tailor made' opportunity to reflect, but our reflection should be in the light of the great Christian celebration of Easter. A shameful death was followed by the glorious Resurrection; the hardships of the past year can be followed by another resurrection in the form of new hope and vision for our world.

May you know God's blessing now and always.

A few days ago, I bought a small bunch of daffodils from our local village shop. I took them home, placed them in water and put them on the window ledge of my study and waited.

I should say that at this stage they were merely flower buds. I bought them in anticipation of them blooming into flowers. I didn't ask for a guarantee from the shop keeper that I would get beautiful flowers, that was more of an unspoken understanding between us.

I didn't have to wait long.

Within a day or two several buds began to respond, no doubt encouraged by the water and the sunlight I had given them. Little by little, each bud slowly opened up to display all its glory, and Spring had arrived at the Vicarage, at least in my study, anyway.

The more I looked at these beautiful flowers, the more I was convinced that they looked like a heavenly throng, proclaiming the glory of God to all who would listen.

I am writing these words during the cold winter days of mid-February. Spring seems a long way off. January was a bleak month for many, and I am not alone in holding on for the Spring.

Spring is coming. I bought the daffs to cheer me up and to give me a foretaste of things to come.

Growing Your Own

Use your vegetables WELL! - Delicious vegetabls soup and MORE!

One of the delights of March is to savour delicious "allotment soup". This is where I make use of various root vegetables which are reasonably immune to the effects of snow, frost and incessant rain. I start the cooking off with finely chopped leeks, browned in the pressure cooker along with some garlic and perhaps the odd onion. Then I add whatever is to hand, such as carrots, turnips if available, a few parsnips, perhaps a few potatoes, celery, perhaps salsify, and complete the mixture with pieces of cooked chicken. After the pressure cooker has done its work I have the most delicious soup one can imagine. Apart, that is, from simple leek and potato soup with a little garlic added, plus crème fraîche at the end of cooking. Two soups to die for!

I have found a way to stop Muntjac deer from eating my carrots, which I leave in the ground all winter. I simply cover the row with a roll of wire chicken netting and that always works. As for celery, I protect the plants against frost by putting fleece over and that seems to work most winters. Some of my celeriac this winter were about twice the diameter of the largest I have grown before; I cover them with fleece and reserve the celeriac to be eaten as a salad as céleri rémoulade, finely grated along with carrots in a food processor, and with mayonnaise, olive oil and capers added before serving. What joy! After all, the whole point of growing your own is to be able to eat really fresh

vegetables and fruit which is rich in nutrients and free of man-made chemicals.

As for work on the allotment and in the garden, March is a month for tidying up and completing the spreading of farmyard manure. The greenhouse should be clean by now and all ready for the new growing year. On one side of my greenhouse there is a deep bed in which I grow tomatoes. The soil, over 12 inches deep, consists of almost pure farmyard manure which has been applied over 30 years, so providing a growing medium which is water-retentive and very, very rich in nutrients. On the other side of my greenhouse I have raised staging on which I place 75-litre bags of multi-purpose compost and use them as grow bags for peppers, aubergines and cucumbers. Before planting out I add generous quantities of slow release fertiliser pellets, since garden centre compost has only a small amount of plant food in the mixture. I start off all my greenhouse crops in a dark, warm place and bring them out into the light as soon as they have germinated, then place them on a warm, sunny windowsill. Some other crops such as celery, celeriac and parsley are started off on the windowsill since they seem to need light to germinate.

## Thoughts from a Seasoned Home Educator

What are your thoughts on home schooling? How are you coping with this current situation whilst juggling work, home schooling and home life? Are the current BUZZ media terms helpful or do they add to our fear of failure and letting our children down?

You see I am a long time home-educator and I take my hat off to every parent thrown in the deep end possibly currently trying to home school their children, whilst working at home or managing their own pandemic stress and concerned that the idyllic calm portrayed in the media, is nothing like their home life and it is certainly nothing like this in our home either, even as home educators of choice with much experience to draw on!

Our home education is noisy and chaotic BUT and it's a big but because it's a long-term thing – we found our rhythm over years not a few months – you guys have been literally thrown in at the deep end and while I can dole out resources and websites and apps in their thousands to all who ask me, being thrown into this without making a conscious decision? This has to be a daunting challenge for some! So from a long term home educator a few tips if I may.

- 1. Fronted Adverbials across the media this phrase is strewn like some sort of secret weapon designed to trip up parents. First of all let's be clear, a) it can be easily understood if you try, b) it's not the end of the world if you don't, c)there will always be one question that trips you up and d) once past primary it's never coming up again.
- 2. Have faith in your skills to teach! Where is the confidence that you can teach your child. Think of the many things you have taught your child, potty training, riding a bike, the list is endless. Yes, teachers are trained to cope with 30 children, to fill in the mountainous load of paperwork and how to assess according to new regimes, how to decode a curriculum and how to teach that across varying age groups but teaching itself is a skill we all do as parents every day. We teach ourselves new skills and when you potty trained and it didn't go well you didn't give up, you kept at it you researched new methods, you asked for help you didn't desert your children teaching maths is no different learn yourself can you find a method that works for you. I hated long division at school I re-learnt it before my kids got there and now I wonder what I was worried about.
- 3. Our kids are NOT a lost generation what an awful phrase. If your child broke their leg or got glandular fever and missed a few months of school you wouldn't write the child off forever so don't let mass media creep into your brain
- 4. Your mental health and also your child's mental health is the most important thing if something isn't working don't battle take a break, do something completely different and come back to it.
- 5. Use this time wisely learn what your child's strengths and weaknesses are. I never knew my child was a maths whizz because the school was obsessed with his inability to spot the phonetic sounds in words. I got to see his brilliance at maths and we discarded the phonics programme that he hated and he learnt to read another way spelling is still tough but he prefers our techniques now rather than worrying about phonics.

Home educating is a joy – those of us that do it are well aware of our perceived weirdness, but it's not a mythical hidden skill – you just need to have a bit of faith in your own skill. Let's hope our schools are teaching our own children to have a little more faith in themselves.






