Guidelines for Articles

Articles should be no longer than 500 words (space is limited in the Gazette. Longer articles can be in the Gazette as a short article and the full length version can be on the website)

Articles should be submitted in an unformatted form with the exception of paragraphs. The editor will format the article to fit the space available in the Gazette. Please remember if you submit your article on A4 format the Gazette column is much narrower and the layout will be different.

Pictures / Artwork in articles. Please do not include images or artwork in your text but send them separately (see section below).

Articles should be in document format (.doc or similar) NOT .pdf

The editor reserves the right to return articles that do not conform to these guidelines but will do everything possible to assist should you have a problem.

Send articles and photographs in the same email to Sonia Goby (Editor) at editor@naphillandwaltersash.org.uk. Please do not resize your image (especially do not use the 'send for email' option available in some photo editing software), we will take care of that for you.

Photographs to go with Articles

Photographs should be relevant to the article

Photographs submitted with articles should not be included in the article but sent as a separate attachment.

All photograph files should be renamed in the following format (this is to help us credit the photographer and find images quickly)

Your name_Subject/Location_your original file number

e.g. Peter Davis_Promrose_img2356
