E-training on Modern Slavery, Human Trafficking..

Modern slavery, human trafficking and exploitation are a sad reality in 2024. Understanding what is meant by these terms is important particularly if you engage with vulnerable people. HSA is sharing this information and asks that readers circulate it more widely within the Hughenden communities.

The training is designed for statutory front line workers **and** those who work in the community supporting people in vulnerable circumstances. It will dispel myths, capture current trends and enable you to be alert to signs of exploitation and human trafficking and understand how pervasive such crimes are. You will see the importance of prevention to protect those who are targeted because they are vulnerable. It will offer insight from a victim's perspective and the barriers to disclosure.
