Surgery Covid19 FAQs



Great news: 2nd Covid19 vaccinations will be available from Tuesday 23rd March! In the meantime the **Practise Manager, Scott Ridley** has highlighted some frequently asked questions (FAQs):

Should I call the surgery?

No, we will contact you by text or telephone. Keep an eye on our website and Facebook pages

I have not had my first vaccination yet, why are your inviting patients for their second?

The NHSE guidance at the moment is for patients to have their 2nd vaccination on or around the 12 weeks mark.

Have you stopped giving the 1st vaccination?

At the moment we are still continuing to do 1st vaccinations.

I have not been invited for any COVID-19 vaccination but normally I receive a Flu jab I must be in the wrong group should I write or call you to ask you to check my group?

We are unable to change your group NHSE and our software providers setup the group lists and can not change them so please do not contact us to make a change.

I have been sent a text to ask to book but it must be wrong as I am fit and healthy, I do not want to take someone else's vaccination should I contact the surgery to cancel?

We all need a vaccination at some point. No, please do not contact the surgery as this will take up valuable care navigation or clinical time that could be used to help other patients with other non COVID-19 problems.

Spotlight On: counter-terrorism



With lockdown measures potentially easing in the coming weeks and more people returning to towns and cities, Counter Terrorism Policing need people to return to being vigilant when out and about. Having more people with a basic level of awareness, and who know what to do if they see suspicious activity, is a real asset to the police.

The international award winning **ACT Awareness E-Learning** was developed in partnership with retail giant **Marks and Spencer** and **Highfield Learning**. The interactive course, which is available to organisations or private individuals, takes just 45 minutes to complete and can be done all in one go or in short modules. It explains how to spot the signs of suspicious behaviour and what to do to help yourself, others and the emergency responders if an attack should take place.
