### Scam of The Week: HMRC Tax Refund

Another HMRC scam email was received in the Editor's mailbox earlier this week suggesting a tax refund of £240.00 (still pending). Again the letter 'l' was in bold throughout the email and it was pretty clear that this was not a genuine HMRC message. HMRC repeatedly confirm that such an email would never be sent out.
