### Smart Motorway Safety Advice



Smart motorways can be found across the Thames Valley and other parts of the country. The 'hard shoulder' has now been designed a 'fourth lane' and there are overhead signs above the lanes which will display important information such as speed limits. It is important to note that driving in a closed lane could result in a fixed penalty notice of up to £100 and 3 points on your licence.
